I am requesting funding for the Voss Rd. Safety Improvement project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Harris County Precinct 4, located at 1001 Preston St. Houston, TX 77002. The funding would be used to rehabilitate Voss Road between San Felipe Street and Westheimer Road through full pavement replacement, improving safety and mobility along this heavily traveled corridor. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Voss Road is a vital connector in West Houston, linking residential communities to commercial centers and connecting this neighborhood to crucial interstate travel. The deteriorated pavement poses risks to motorists and cyclists, and past patchwork repairs have failed to address the underlying issues

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
