
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Grant Road Storm Sewer Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Harris County Precinct 3, located at 1414 Wirt Rd., Houston, TX 77055. The funding would be used for widening a two-mile segment of Grant Rd. from a two-lane road with roadside ditches to a four-lane concrete boulevard with storm sewer, raised median, and sidewalks. It will also install approximately 5,200 feet of underground concrete drainage facilities that will provide immediate drainage relief, enable the development of thousands of new homes to support the growing community, and support the drainage requirements for the next phases of construction. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it reduces flood risk by increasing floodwater conveyance, alleviates traffic congestion, and improves driver and pedestrian safety.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 23 USC 133.
