
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Interstate 10 Underpass Lighting – Phase 2 in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Harris County Improvement District 4, located at 777 North Eldridge Parkway suite 270, Houston, TX 77079. The funding would be used to install electrical conduit and lighting at three major intersections underneath the elevated Interstate 10 (I-10) in the heart of the Energy Corridor. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these improvements are critical public safety measures necessary for safe public spaces, pedestrian crossings, and vehicular turning movements. With these improvements, the right-of-way underneath I-10 will be a safe, well-lit space that supports better community connectivity.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
