
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Jersey Village Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Reliability and Resiliency Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The City of Jersey Village, Texas, located at 16327 Lakeview Dr., Jersey Village, TX 77040. The funding would be used for the city's water treatment plants, wastewater treatment plant, lift stations, and collection infrastructure include aging electrical components, motor control centers, pumping equipment, and chemical feed systems that are approaching or have exceeded their intended service life. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because, as growth and system demand continue, these facilities must operate with consistent reliability to meet state and federal requirements for drinking water and wastewater treatment.
