
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Memorial Village Police Department Communication Equipment and Vehicle Replacement project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Memorial Villages Police Department, located at 11981 Memorial Drive, Houston, TX 77024. The funding would be used for the purchase of 35 hand-held radios, 16 in-car radios, and 1 fully marked patrol vehicle. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the current radios and patrol vehicle have passed their use of life and are no longer fully reliable pieces of equipment.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
