
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Tomball Hills Subdivision – Camille Drive Drainage Improvements and Extension in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The City of Tomball, Texas, located at 401 Market St., Tomball, TX 77375. The funding would be used for installing stormwater inlets and storm sewer infrastructure along Camille Drive from Alice Lane westward to a detention pond.
