
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Tomball Police Department Vehicle Replacement project in Fiscal Year 2027. The funding would be used for the replacement of nine (9) marked police patrol cars and one (1) detainee transport van. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project is necessary to ensure that the Tomball Police Department has reliable, safe, and properly equipped vehicles to effectively serve and protect their community. Replacing these vehicles is critical to maintaining operational readiness and officer safety.
